MEETING MINUTES April 20, 2021: Lodi Rod & Gun Club

Call to Order

Meeting called to order by President Greg Wadhams at 7:06 P.M.

We were advised that the NYSCC also supports this.

Scholarship committee: Bill Ryan inquired to see if we were going to offer the scholarship this year. There was also discussion about whether this would be for 2021 grads only or open it up to 2020 grads. Motion made to include both (Ed 1st; Ron 2nd); motion carried.
